## Price reduction on St. Moritz mountain railways ENGADINcard 365 for second-home owners

As a token of appreciation to second-home owners, some Upper Engadine municipalities are granting them a 10% price reduction on the St. Moritz Mountain Railways ENGADINcard 365 for the next three years. You can purchase your ENGADINcard 365 as usual at a mountain railway ticket office or online from the mountain railway webshop at the published price, 10% of which will be reimbursed to you.

### Eligible are:

### a) Sole owners

- Owners according to the land register, and their partner (married or in a registered partnership)
- o All children of the owner and/or partner under the age of 18.

#### b) Co-owners

- All co-owners according to the land register, and their partners
- All children of the owner and/or partner under the age of 18.

# c) Legal entities

 1 discount per room according to the land register/official valuation; all beneficiaries are to be listed by name in an extract from the minutes of the company board of directors or similar

Please bring the original receipt of your mountain railway subscription to the municipal office together with:

- o the subscription holder's identity card
- o details of your bank account
- o for legal entities: a list of persons authorised as apartment owners (extract from the minutes of the supervisory board or similar.
